PCCSC Men's and Women's Singlehanded Conference Championships
September 24-26, 2010

Boats: The regatta will be sailed in Lasers (Men) and Radials (Women). Each competitor must provide one complete Class Legal Laser (Men) or Radial (Women).

Entries/Eligibility: All PCCSC Regular or Provisional Member Schools in good standing are eligible to sail. A maximum of 4 sailors per school will be allowed in each championship. As per the PCCSC Standing Rules, all competitors are required to wear their school pinnies to help identify sailors both from ashore and from the committee boats.

EACH COMPETITOR OR REPRESENTATIVE (COACH, TEAM CAPTAIN, ETC.) MUST NOTIFY THE US SAILING CENTER (VIA EMAIL, FAX OR PHONE) BY SEPTEMBER 20, 2010 OF THEIR INTENTION TO COMPETE.

ALL FEMALE COMPETITORS MUST BE PRESENT BY 0930 SEPTEMBER 24 AND ALL MALE COMPETITORS MUST BE PRESENT BY 0930 SEPTEMBER 25 OR YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SAIL!!

There will be a \$15.00 per competitor entry fee payable by 1000 on September 24 (Female) and September 25 (Male), 2010. Make checks payable to PCSF (Pacific Coast Sailing Foundation).

Format: The women's championship will be sailed on Friday. A minimum of five races must be completed and a maximum of 18 will be attempted. If five races are not completed Friday, they will be sailed Saturday morning. The men's championship will be sailed on Saturday (following any women's races still to be sailed) and Sunday. A minimum of five races must be completed and a maximum of 18 will be attempted. The regatta will be a single division, Varsity, non-rotational event. You will sail the boat that you bring. Top two finishers will qualify for the ICSA Singlehanded National Championship.

Safety: U.S. Coast Guard approved PFDs (Type III, minimum) shall be worn at all times on the water.

Housing: Limited housing may be available. Contact Mike Segerblom at the US Sailing Center for more information BEFORE September 17th, 2010!
